- When parking on the street please do not block mail boxes per ordinance.
- If there is 2" of snow predicted to fall you will need to find an alternative to street parking. When removing snow from private property, please do not put snow in the roads per ordinance.



Blood pressure checks are held weekly at Rapid City Village Hall on Thursdays.

With the New Year upon us why not start out healthy? To have your blood pressure checked please visit the Village Office on Thursdays at 10:00am. If Medics have an

emergency call pressure checks may be canceled without notice.

Have you noticed a street light flickering or out completely? To report street light issues please report online at www.midamericanenergy.com or by calling the Village Office. MidAmerican Energy will be gradually migrating our street lights to LED lighting as the current lights become inoperable. By switching the street lights to LED bulbs the Village is projected to save approximately \$25.00 per street light per year.

Cemetery maps are available at the Village Office. If you own a plot and would like to have a view of the cemetery to attach with your deeds call or come to the Village Office to get your copy. If you don't own a plot but are interested in information please stop by or call the Village Office. Rapids City residents are able to purchase plots at a cost of \$150.00 per plot currently.



Inspections are an annual event for anyone within the Village with a backflow preventer connected to their water service line. It is very important home owners get inspections completed with inspection reports to the Village Office on or before April 1st of each year, **no exceptions**. Annually backflow inspections are required per Village Ordinance Title VIII, Chapter 1, Article 8, Section 4, 4.1; this ordinance may be found at www.rapidscity.us.

I hope everyone had a joyous and wonderful holiday season and I wish all of you a safe and prosperous New Year. I just would like to take a minute to share with you some information on recent and upcoming events in Our Village.

We held our 1st Annual Thanksgiving Senior Luncheon on 11/16/17 and it was truly a wonderful feeling to see so many of our seniors enjoying themselves. From a personal perspective it was very rewarding to see this event come to fruition. I want to once again thank the financial donors who made this possible; the MSA employees Chris and Steve, my wife, Cindy Mire, Board Trustees Richard Fiems and Carolyn Fowler, all of whom served the great food and the **Village staff, Missy, Carol and Mark who worked tirelessly and without whose efforts this could not have been possible.** I also want to thank the entire Board of Trustees for approving this event. While some were unable to share in this festive event through no fault of their own, they were there in spirit and were just as proud as all of us. I can't wait to do this again next year.

The IL Route 84 Flag project honoring our country and its brave service people, active and retired, was completed 7 months ahead of schedule due to the generous donations of so many people. All meetings will be held at the Village Hall. I encourage you to attend and share your suggestions with the Board.

I will be hosting a **BUSINESS OWNER'S MEETING ON JANUARY 24, 2018 AT 6:00PM and a RESIDENT TOWN HALL MEETING ON FEBRUARY 21, 2018 AT 6:00PM; BOTH at the VILLAGE HALL.** I hope to see you there so we can share our vision for the future of the Village.
