

Village of Rapids City
Liquor Control Commission
Public Hearing Minutes
April 22nd, 2019

President Harold J. Mire Jr. acting as Liquor Control Commissioner of the Village of Rapids City called this Public Hearing to order at 6:00pm.

Those in attendance were Clerk Housenga, Kristin VanDuyne and Konni Stapf.

Mire acknowledge of application of a Liquor License by Kristin VanDuyne for GiLanella's under section 3.6 of the Beer and Liquor Ordinance. Mire gave a copy of the Judgment from January 31st, 2018 hearing dated February 5th, 2018 to review as Exhibit A.

Konni Stapf swore in Kristin VanDuyne.

VanDuyne confirmed and acknowledged Exhibit A as detailing the violations of previous offenses.

Mire asked Ms. VanDuyne to explain why she felt he should waive section 3.6 of the Rapids City Beer and Liquor Ordinance.

Ms. VanDuyne stated she has done everything to comply with local and state requirements, the state has inspected the GiLanella's and everything is just as it should be.

Mire confirmed Ms. VanDuyne agreed to and conducted a background check with everything coming back clear.

Mire confirmed a clear background check result with Clerk Housenga.

Mire considered this case a very difficult case and gave it a lot of thought. Mire gave Ms. VanDuyne his ruling verbally as to not delay Ms. VanDuyne from obtaining a State Liquor License, adding she would receive written confirmation of the ruling via mail. After review of all documentation, testimony, provisions of the Village of Rapids City Beer and Liquor Control Ordinance and conduct of Ms. VanDuyne, Mire ruled to waive Title II, Chapter 6, Article 4, Section 3.6 of the Village of Rapids City Code of Ordinances. Ms. VanDuyne owner of GiLanella's was granted approval her license application. A Class I Liquor License will be issued effective May 1st, 2019 in accordance to the ruling.

A bond of \$750.00 was posted as required by ordinance. All charges for these proceedings and administrative paperwork fees. Mire waived any fees he is due for these proceedings.

Mire wished Ms. VanDuyne success with her business and with comments Mire adjourned the meeting at 6:08pm.
